The nongovernmental Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA) is a self-regulatory organization (SRO) that oversees the securities industry in the United States. It is a not-for-profit organization that is subject to oversight by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). FINRA's primary mission is to protect investors, ensure the integrity of the financial markets, and facilitate capital formation. It does this by writing rules, examining and enforcing compliance with those rules, registering broker-dealer personnel, offering education and training, and informing the investing public. FINRA also provides surveillance and other regulatory services for equities and options markets, as well as trade reporting and other industry utilities.

FINRA is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to investor protection and market integrity. It regulates one critical part of the securities industry—brokerage firms doing business with the public in the United States. FINRA, overseen by the SEC, writes rules, examines for, and enforces compliance with FINRA rules and federal securities laws, registers broker-dealer personnel and offers them education and training, and informs the investing public. FINRA provides surveillance and other regulatory services for equities and options markets, as well as trade reporting and other industry utilities.
